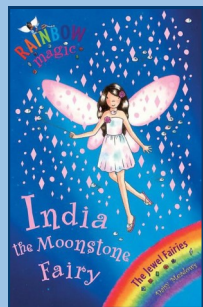

Peanut Jones and the Illustrated City

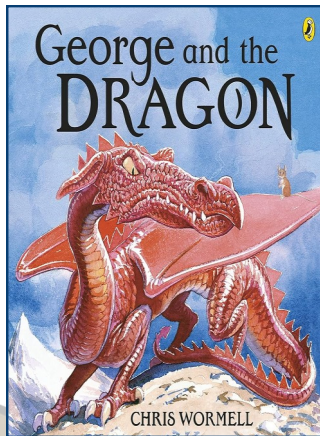

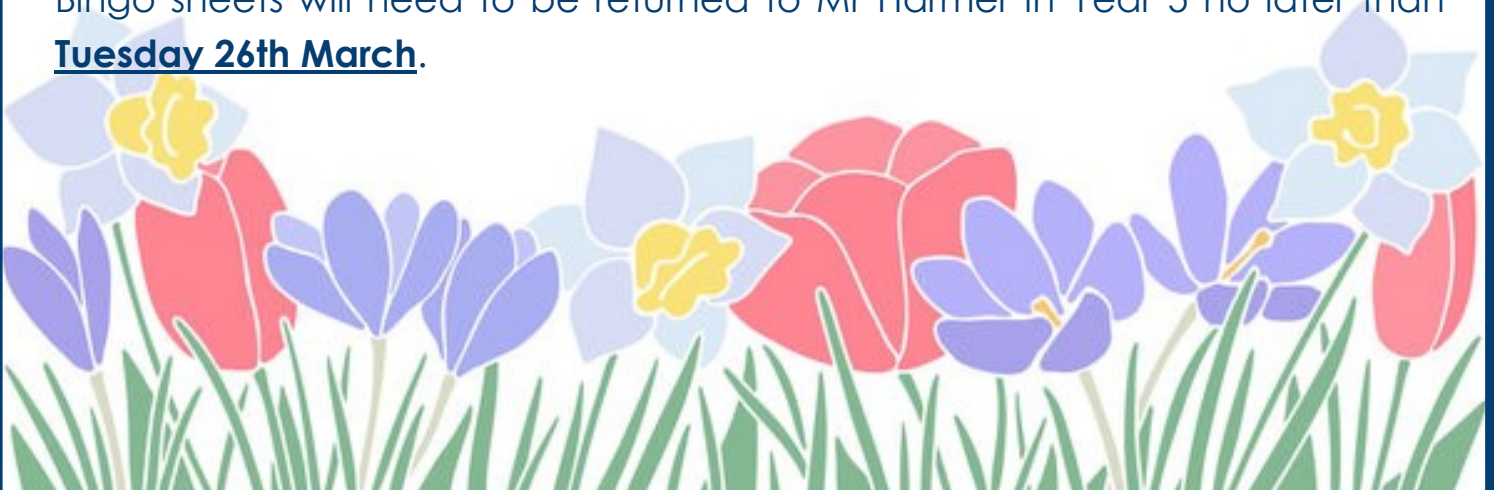
Spring Reading Bingo

Every child that completes the Spring Reading Bingo will receive a certificate and be entered into a prize draw to win a book from the book vending machine!

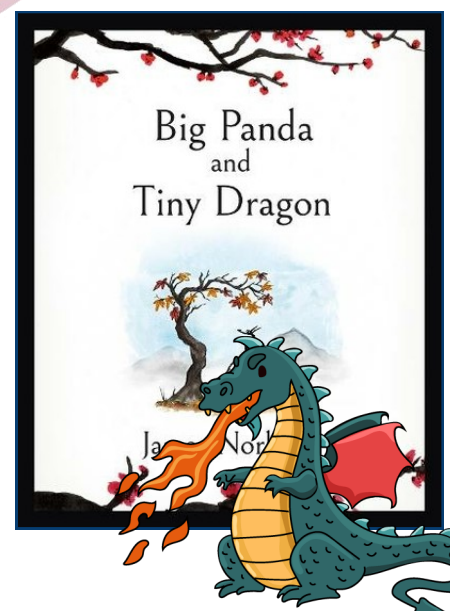
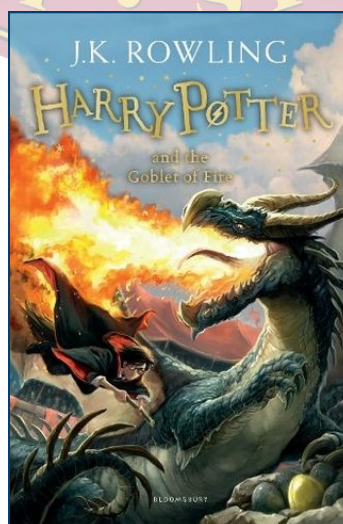
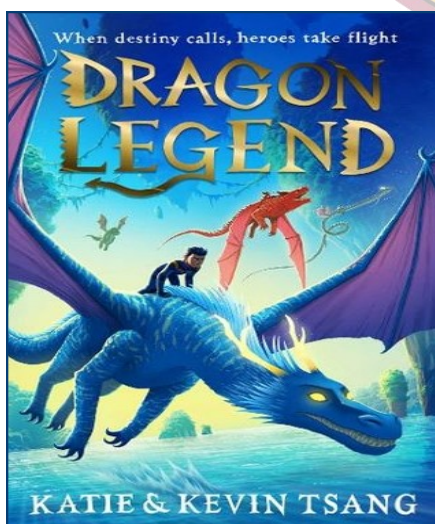
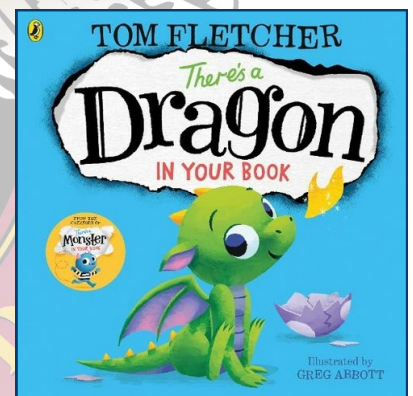
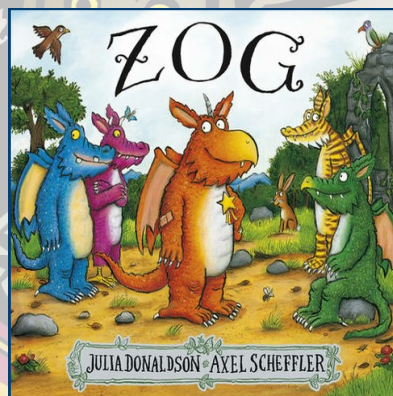
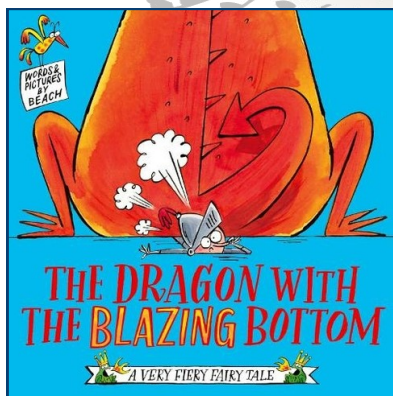
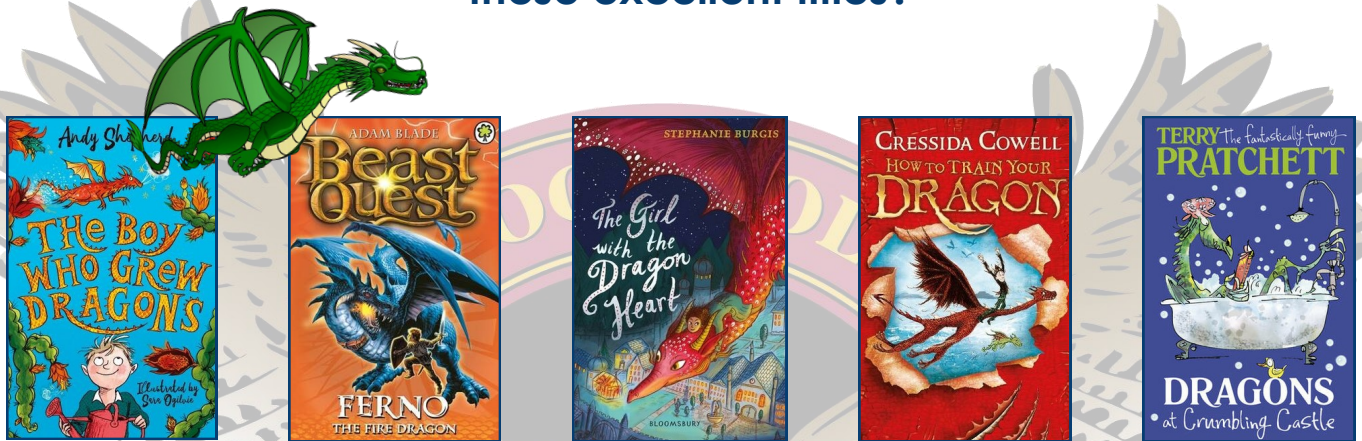
