## **SPORTS DAY**

Weather permitting this year (fingers crossed!) we will be holding our Sports Day on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June. Fledglings, Reception and KS1 will be competing between 9.15 am and 11.15 am, and KS2 will compete between 12.30 pm and 3.00 pm. All children will need to wear their Wood Fold PE kit which they will get changed into when they arrive at school. Fledglings children should wear trainers, shorts and a t-shirt. Hurdle race.

Children who currently have a school dinner will have a 'picnic bag' prepared for them so they can also eat outside on the day.
