A reminder that in accordance with the School's Attendance Policy and the Local Authority's Code of Conduct, holidays in term time cannot be authorised.

You could receive an Educational Penalty Notice if your child falls within one or more of these categories within a 12-week period:

- 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence with under 90% attendance.
- ◆ 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised
  ★ absence.
  - persistently arrives late for school after the close of registration.
