# **Parental Questionnaire Results**

Thank you to all those parents who took the time to complete the Parent Survey Questionnaire, we had 158 responses! The results of this and the comments made were incredibly positive and the suggestions you made in relation to areas that need to be addressed moving forward will be used to inform our decision making.
