Y5 Visit to Tatton Park

In order to support our 'Anglo Saxons' history learning this term, the Year 5 children will be visiting Tatton Park on Thursday 6th February. The children will be leaving school at 9.00 am and will be returning to school for 3.00 pm, traffic permitting. Please can the children arrive at school at 8.40 am on the day of their trip, in order that the register may be taken before a prompt departure from school at 9.00 am.

During the day the children will explore the turbulent world of the Anglo Saxons and Vikings in 10th Century AD in this exciting, hands-on workshop. The cost of this visit will be £16.55 per child to cover the cost of the visit to Tatton Park, coach and insurance. The children should wear their normal school uniform and sensible shoes and bring a waterproof coat.

Children who normally have a school meal will be provided with a packed lunch from the kitchen, which will include a choice of sandwich, biscuit, fruit and a drink.

During our visit there will not be an opportunity to visit the shop, and therefore no spending money is required. Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1988, there is no obligation to contribute to the cost and no child will be omitted from the activity because his/her parents are unwilling or unable to pay. However, it will be necessary to have substantial parental contributions in order that the activity takes place. If there are insufficient voluntary contributions the event will be cancelled. Please let the school know if there is a genuine case of hardship or are unwilling to pay, as you will still need to give consent for your child to take part on ParentPay. The matter will be dealt with in strictest confidence.
